The countries are KAZAKSTAN, HUNGARY, POLAND, MOLDOVA, MACEDONIA, SLOVAKIA, UKRAINE, SERBIA, CZECH REPUBLIC, CROATIA, ROMANIA and BULGARIA.

Can you identify them all?

Here are some clues for you to work out to help you identify them:

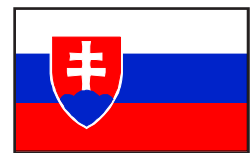
1. Two flags are almost identical except that MOLDOVA has a badge in the middle.
2. Two flags have identical stripes and colours but HUNGARY does not have red at the bottom.
3. The flag from POLAND is identical to the one from Czech Republic if you remove the blue part.
4. MACEDONIA has a flag without stripes and does not have a blue background.
5. There is no red on the flag of UKRAINE but it has stripes.
6. The flag with a triangle is from the CZECH REPUBLIC
7. The flag for KAZAKSTAN has the same colours as Ukraine but there are no stripes.
8. Three vertical stripes are on the flag from ROMANIA and it looks like another flag on the sheet.
9. SLOVAKIA has a badge on its flag the same colour as the three stripes on it.
10. The flag from CROATIA has three stripes but also has a badge in the middle.
11. The flag from SERBIA has a white stripe in the middle.
12. Three colours and three stripes are on the flag from BULGARIA and it looks similar to the flag from Hungary.
